The participants wrote essays, paragraphs and made paintings on the theme 'A vision for developed India'.
- On 11<sup>th</sup> May, another drafting article activity was conducted on the theme - A Vision for developed India. On 16<sup>th</sup> May, National Dengue Day was celebrated with the organization of a special assembly & displaying of a Power Point Presentation.
